Early Childhood application day will be on
March 20, 2018 from 1:30 to 3:00.

Families will need to bring the following...

- Certified copy of the child's birth certificate
- Immunization record (up to date for age)
- Address verification (OPPD, MUD, Cox bill, or Lease)
- Income verification for the previous 12 months (TANF/ ADC, SSI, Child Support, 1040, 1099, W-2s, 8453, 12 months of check stubs, or letter from employer)

The child will be administered an academic screening during the enrollment.
